Definitions of Deployed Forces Support



- *Deployed Forces Support consists of the following five (5) programs.*
 - *Afloat - Shipboard Recreation and Fitness. Actual programs and facilities that are conducted on a ship at sea, in-port or in a yard period.*
 - *DFS - Shore MWR Offices that support home-ported ships (N=13).*
 - *Afloat Recreation Inspection Management System (ARIMS)*
 - *Afloat Recreation Program Management Course (ARPM)*
 - *Community Recreation - Will serve as the primary contact for visiting ships and squadrons at bases that do not have home-ported ships*

- ***Afloat Fun and Fit Bosses***

- ***CNIC Afloat Civilian Program (36 Fun & Fit Bosses) - onboard aircraft carriers, large deck amphibious assault ships and only on hospital ships during major deployments.***
- ***36 Billets Permanently Assigned to the Fleet***
- ***Fun & Fit Bosses - Are CNIC NAF employees that report to CNIC administratively and to their respective shipboard commands operationally.***
- ***Fun and Fit Bosses - Both provide monthly data/metrics for each program area. The Fun and Fit Bosses reach nearly 85,000 Sailors and Marines annually at sea, in-port and yard periods. These positions are full-time onboard their respective ships.***

- **DFS**

- **CNIC Afloat Recreation Program Management Course** – 15 instructors around the world, roughly 50 courses annually instructing about 600 RSO, RFC, DFS and Afloat staff.
- **Shipboard Afloat Recreation Fund Inspection Program** – about 320 inspections overall during 18 month period.
- **Program Instructions & Standards** – **CNIC 1710.5 ADMINISTRATION OF AFLOAT RECREATION PROGRAMS** signed out in November of 2017; standards updated 2018.
- **Fitness & Recreation Equipment Resourcing** – Includes 13 DFS Warehouses Worldwide that support all USS SHIPS and forward deployed Navy Ground Forces.

- **Ongoing Initiatives:**

- ***DFS/Afloat Desk Guides completed in 2018, resources added as needed and found on DFS website.***
- ***Continual DFS website updates.***
- ***MSC fitness equipment initiatives with Support Agreement for funding.***
- ***Continued push to installation DFS offices and ARPM Course Facilitators on Afloat Inspection data collected from inspections.***
- ***Coordination with outside organizations for Fleet Support to include; OPNAV, NAVSEA, NAVSUP, NEXCOM, Military Sealift Command, Fleet Forces Command and COMPACFLT and various others.***
