

- The Afloat Library Program is managed by the Library Officer, per OPNAV instruction.
- Library Officers are appointed by the XO and may be a Petty Officer. On large decks, the Library Officer is typically the Chaplain; on a smaller vessel it is an assigned Religious Program Specialist.
- The Navy General Library Program outfits all new ships and submarines with a new library, provides paperback books to the fleet and other library materials if supplemental funding is provided.





- Provides guidance on the operation of afloat libraries to include the disposal of all library equipment and materials.
- Library Multimedia Resource Centers (LMRCs) use space-saving digital technology to increase the holdings of afloat libraries by enabling the storage of reading materials on computer media and providing email and Internet connectivity.
- The technology supports access to accredited educational programs that enable crewmembers to pursue advanced education opportunities.





 New Ship/Sub Library Outfitting: with funding from NAVSEA, every new ship and submarine is outfitted with a library consisting of laptops, hardback books, paperbacks, magazines, Playaways, DVDs, small electronics, games and other materials as determined by ship personnel

- (NMPS) procures and distributes entertainment motion pictures and related equipment to afloat units within the Navy.
- Entertainment motion pictures are leased, rather than purchased and as such, lease agreements contain specific provisions governing the use of the media with regard to viewing locations and patron eligibility.
- Program management for film entertainment in the Navy lies solely with NMPS; commands and individuals are prohibited from using APF or NAF, contacting, or negotiating with any commercial source for the purpose of procuring entertainment motion picture products.
